Meeting Minutes

Treasury Report: Annie Coakley

- Drafting 2023 budget but City of Evanston is putting in \$610,995 levy for 2023; Annie will set up call to review draft budget
 - Will have \$100,000 that is not being used from maintenance to use toward budget
- Advertising: \$14,500 remaining and getting a \$3000 credit from CVB for WBBM ads
- Events: \$5,500 remaining
 - Fall Fest Oct. 9 | \$4,000 in expenses after income from sponsorship, t-shirts, beer
 - Small Business Saturday Nov. 26 | Giveaway for Shopping Passport
 - Warm Bevvy Walk Dec. 1, 4-7pm
 - Holiday Light Celebration Dec. 3, 5-7pm

- Holiday Decor: \$65,000
 - Scott Parrish, Illuminight proposal to wrap tree trunks along Sherman, Davis,
 Orrington and Church
 - Working with larger properties (Rotary, 1603 Orrington, Church Street Plaza) to contribute to holiday lighting expenses
 - Businesses pay for electricity for tree lights
 - Mike motioned to vote that holiday lighting expenses should not exceed \$65,000
 - Board voted unanimously to approve that lighting expenses should not exceed \$65,000
- Public Way Maintenance/Landscaping
 - o City approved Street level planters are complete one-time expense
 - DTE still has a contract with Brightview to provide garbage removal services through Dec. 2022 but with Streetsplus starting in November we will have \$18K credit from Brightview
 - Use money to power clean business awnings Church/Davis
